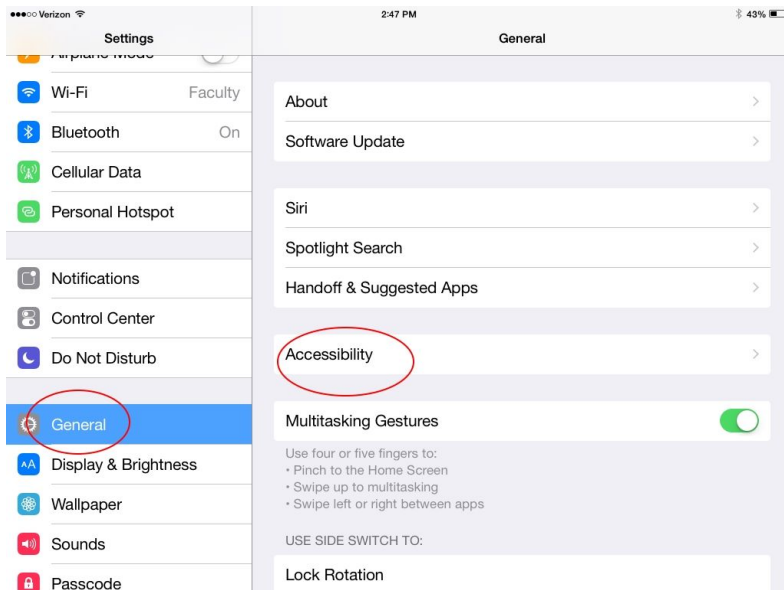
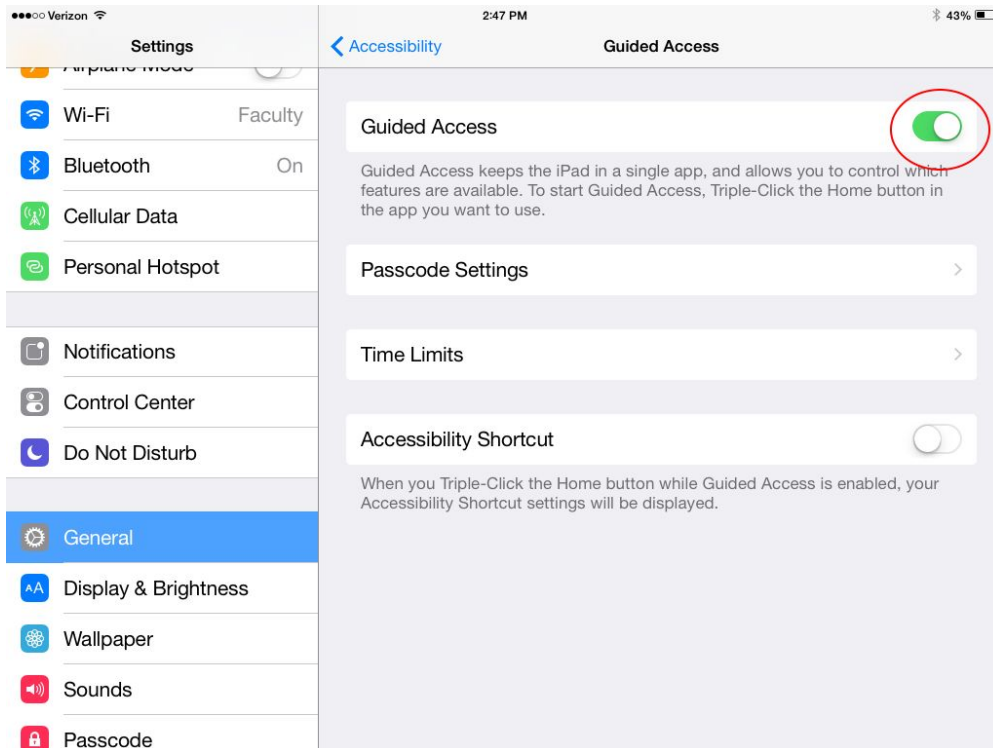
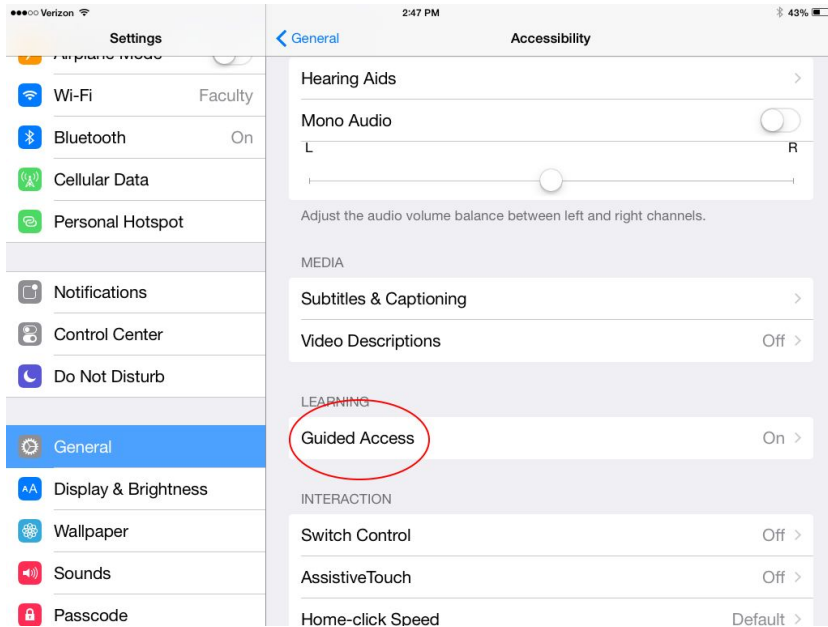


**ERB requires the CTP be taken in Guided Access mode which prevents test takers to leave the test and peruse the web.**

**To turn Guided Access on and off, have students go to: Settings>General>Accessibility**



**Then Click on Guided Access and turn it on. They will be prompted for a password. Insist they use “1234”. They will be asked for it more than once and it is easy to remember. If they set it as something else and cannot remember it, their iPad will have to be wiped and restored.**



**Then go to the ERB CTP app and tap Verify Readiness**

## Verify Readiness

iPads use a wireless network connection which should be checked prior to testing to verify its ability to support multiple, concurrent, test takers.

Launch the test simulation on multiple iPads at the same time to simulate the network traffic of several test takers at your test site. We recommend you coordinating the verification process with your IT staff, so they can monitor network performance during the exercise.



Launch Test Simulation

Before starting a test, Guided Access must be enabled to ensure test security.

Guided Access is currently:

**Again, if this says disabled, click the home button (the round button at the bottom of the iPad screen) three times quickly and it will enable. At this point the iPad will not go out of ERB app.**

**To quit the app, press the Home button three times quickly again and enter the passcode. You will get a screen where you can choose end or resume (if you've done it accidentally and want to stay in ERB)**

**When finished with all testing, students may turn off the Guided Access in the Settings menu.**
